
Reports about adults with disability **most commonly involved a parent*** as the subject of allegation.



of reports about older people involved family members, mainly adult children followed by the adult's spouse or partner,* as the subject of allegation.



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards older people (OP) were verbal abuse, failure to meet support needs and restricting access to supports/services – and family/others.*`



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) were restricting access to supports/services, failure to meet support needs and financial exploitation.*


