
Clarence Valley



The Ageing & Disability Commission (ADC) received 80 reports of alleged abuse, neglect and exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from Clarence Valley in 2020-2022*.






Reports about adults with disability most commonly involved a parent* as the subject of allegation


