
## Ku-ring-gai



The Ageing & Disability Commission (ADC) received 85 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from Ku-ring-gai in 2020-2022\*.





Reports about adults with disability most commonly involved a parent\* as the subject of allegation



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards older people (OP) were verbal abuse, financial exploitation and restricting access to family/others\*`




The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) were hitting, punching or kicking, failure to meet support needs and verbal abuse\*


