

The Ageing & Disability Commission (ADC) received **153** reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from **Liverpool** in 2020-2022*.

73% of reports received in this LGA related to an older person*



76% of reports about adults with disability were made by a paid worker^



40% of reports about **older people** came from a **paid worker**^

- **31%** of reports came from the child of the older person
- 7% of reports came from the older person experiencing abuse


6 reports were about an adult who identified as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander~ 33

reports involved an adult who spoke a language other than English at home with **Vietnamese** and **Arabic*** the most common languages reported


