
## **Mid Coast**



The Ageing & Disability Commission (ADC) received **158** reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from the Mid Coast in 2020-2022\*.






Reports about adults with disability most commonly involved a parent\* as the subject of allegation

The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) kicking/punching, failure to meet


support needs, verbal abuse and theft of money`

7.3% of the population identified as **Aboriginal or Torres** Strait Islander (ATSI)<sub>1</sub>




**66%** of all households are family households 31% are single person households and 3% are group households<sub>2</sub>
