
## **Orange**



The Ageing & Disability Commission (ADC) received **51** reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from Orange in 2020-2022\*.




Reports relating to the abuse of adults with disability most commonly involved a community member\* as the subject of allegation Community member Child Parent Partner -

64% of reports about older people involved family members, mainly adult children followed by a partner or spouse,\* as the subject of allegation


The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) were failure to meet support needs, restricting access to support needs and financial exploitation\*`
