


The Ageing & Disability Commission (ADC) received 147 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from Penrith in 2020-2022*.




* Information taken from the Ageing & Disability Commission data on reports received between 1 January 2020 - 31 December 2022 where the location of the adult identified in the report was known.

A paid worker is defined as a formal paid support worker, for example an NDIS support worker or CHSP provider.
People who identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander and who are over 18 with disability, or an older person 50+





What else do we know about the Penrith community?



The ADC classifies abuse into 5 broad categories, with a list of signs to indicate the type of alleged abuse reported. <u>12021 Census data by LGA (QuickStats)</u> 2 2021 Census QuickStats, where group household refers to unrelated flatmate or co-tenancy arrangements.
