


The Ageing & Disability Commission (ADC) received **85** reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from **Randwick** in 2020 - 2022\*.






Reports about adults with disability most commonly involved a **parent\*** as the subject of allegation



**56%** of reports about older people involved family members, **mainly adult children**, followed by a friend,\* as the subject of allegation



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards older people (OP) were **verbal abuse, financial exploitation and restricting access to family/others\***



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) were **failure to meet support needs and neglect of medical care\***


