
Reports about adults with disability **most commonly involved a paid worker*** as the subject of allegation



75% of reports about older people involved family members, mainly adult children, as the subject of allegation*



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards older people (OP) were verbal abuse, restricting access to family and misuse of Power of Attorney`




The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) were financial exploitation, failure to meet support needs, and kicking/punching the adult`


