

The Ageing & Disability Commission (ADC) received **80** reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from **Shellharbour** in 2020-2022\*.




reports involved an adult who spoke a language other than English at home with **Spanish** and **Italian**\* the most common languages reported


