
## Shoalhaven






A paid worker is defined as a formal paid support worker, for example an NDIS support worker or CHSP provider.






Reports about adults with disability **most** commonly involved a parent\* as the subject of allegation



of reports about older people involved family members, mainly adult children followed by paid staff member,\* as the subject of allegation



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards older people (OP) were verbal abuse, Financial exploitation and failure to meet support needs`



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) were failure to meet support needs, verbal abuse and restricting access to family/others`




