
Tweed Shire






A paid worker is defined as a formal paid support worker, for example an NDIS support worker or CHSP provider.




Reports about adults with disability most commonly involved a parent* as the subject of allegation



60% of reports about older people involved family members, mainly adult children followed by paid staff,* as the subject of allegation



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards older people (OP) were verbal abuse, financial exploitation and restricting access to family/others`



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) were restricting access to support. failure to meet support needs and verbal abuse`
