




The Ageing & Disability Commission (ADC) received 120 reports related to allegations of abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from the **Central** Coast in 2020*.






Reports about adults with disability **most commonly involved the parent*** as the subject of allegation.



of reports about older people involved family members, mainly adult children followed by the adults spouse or partner, as the subject of allegation.*



The most commonly reported type of abuse towards older people were verbal abuse, failure to meet support needs and financial exploitation.*



The most commonly reported type of abuse towards adults with disability were restricting access to family, financial exploitation and failure to meet support needs.*


